Kerry Fearon wins Pure Country Album of the Year

Northern Irish Songbird Kerry Fearon is the winner of the Pure Country Album of the Year at the Academy of Western Artists Awards with her debut album; Honky Tonk Girl.

The 24th Annual Will Rogers Academy of Western Artists Awards ceremony took place on August 13th in Fort Worth, Texas. Kerry had been nominated in two different categories - Pure Country Female and Pure Country Album and she had planned to attend the original awards back in April when she was looking forward to presenting some awards and performing on stage. However, Kerry's travel plans and the original award ceremony date were cancelled due to Covid-19. Travel restrictions were still in place for the rescheduled date but Kerry was able to watch live online through

the night.
Kerry, who presents the
Boots 'n' Roots Show on
Dundalk FM, was up
against artists such as Jason
James, Dennis Ledbetter,
Weldon Henson; all of
whom she greatly admires
so winning Pure Country
Album came as a huge
surprise.

Kerry began her singing career just five years ago. This isn't Kerry's first award, her talent was recognised from early on in her career; reaching the final of the TG4 competition Glór Tíre in 2016. She also won the prestigious Hot Disc Horizon award for Most Successful British & Irish Newcomer (2017) and a Hot Country award in 2018.

The Will Rogers' Cowboy Awards was established to recognise distinguished Western Artists. The AWA is a growing group of dedicated members and supporters who support and work to bring more

visibility to Contemporary Western Artists.

Steve began his career in the late 1960s spending seven years in pop band The next one, hopefully, will be Sarah Jory Band. I haven't heard of any clubs in the Home Counties returning yet. I know indoor live music is now allowed but with no

many people off. I will go to Chichester CMC if their gig with Pete Brazil is still on in a couple of weeks., it is one of the few listening clubs in the south east.

Also I just asked Jo at the Carolina if she has any thoughts about returning, she said 'Hi Nick, thank you, I am enjoying your old videos.

'I am waiting to hear from the school, it was said after half term (October) but I'm not holding my breath. 'Hope you are keeping safe.'

I have also uploaded another vintage video to YouTube, this is Sarah Jory & The Sarah Jory Band at the Congleton CMC in Cheshire on 24th November 1994. Congleton was a concert venue and this video shows multi-instrumentalist Sarah at her very best. Sarah was a regular visitor to the Congleton Country Music Club, always attracting a large audience. In 1994 club organiser Derek Lawrence booked the Congleton Town Hall as the usual club venue at Buglawton was too small to accommodate the large number of people who always wanted to see her. Sarah Jory was born in Reading, Berkshire in 1969. She loved her parents' Country records

and began playing steel

guitar when she was five; her musical talents were quickly recognised. She appeared in a Country club the following year and made her television debut when she was eight. Her father Arthur became her manager and she joined Colorado Country, Her first album Sarah's Steel Line released in 1981, was however made with the Warrington band Poacher. She worked with Colorado Country for four years, followed by an assortment of gigs while she completed her schooling. She regularly went to the USA playing at steel guitar conventions and at thirteen she played at the Steel Guitar Convention in St. Louis with Buddy Emmons, regarded by many as the world's foremost pedal steel guitarist of his day. In 1985 she spent some time developing a new act around the pub circuit in Bristol and formed a new, fully professional band. In 1985, the British Country Music Association voted Sarah 'The Most Promising New Act', followed by being voted the 'Female Vocalist of the Year' for nine consecutive years by the BCMA. She was also voted European Country Rock Entertainer of the In 1992 she signed to Ritz

Records releasing a single,

Never Had It So Good and

an album, New Horizons, that year. Two further albums followed in 1994 and 1995.

In 2007 Sarah Jory was the

In 2007 Sarah Jory was the eighth Inductee into the British Country Music Hall of Fame. She played pedal steel with the Van Morrison band during 2006 and 2009 and performed on his albums, Keep It Simple and Astral Weeks Live at the Hollywood Bowl. In 2009 she performed with the group Essence of Ireland on a major tour. She continues to perform both as a solo artist, as a guest band member at numerous festivals in Europe and with her band throughout the UK. In September 2018 she celebrated her 40th anniversary with a mini tour. To coincide with the tour, she released a new cd Sarah Jory - The 40th Anniversary 2018, this included four new tracks. For the tour she was reunited with some of her former band members Shane O'Borne on lead guitar, Tony Kaempf on bass guitar (since 1985), Dave Bailey on keys and Barrie Cooper on drums. 3rd Sunday CMC, Surrey

Hello Rob, Greetings from 3rd Sunday CMC in Woking.

I thought it may be helpful to update you on where we are at.

I also organise all the music entertainment at the social club where our Country music club is held. We have recently been given permission by our local council to run live music performances, although it is subject to tight Covid-19 control measures including: Restricted audience numbers to reflect social distancing: Musicians with social distancing between them (except those who live together; No dancing; Audience to remain seated except to use facilities and purchase drinks; and music to be at moderate volumes (people should not have to raise their voices to have conversations These are in addition to our other hygiene controls within the club (eg: signing in all attendees; staff behind screens; one-way route; and anti-bacterial gels and sprays, etc). We have also been given approval to recommence dancing lessons provided these are also controlled with social distancing, no changing partners and held dancing lessons in October (monthly on Sunday afternoons).

I am not recommencing the CMC as this is heavily reliant on a line dancing audience and I am not sure that this can be organised safely indoors or that my largely female audience would be confident to attend at present. We are not a 'listening audience' CMC nor would I want us to become one.

I would be really interested to know if any other clubs are restarting line dancing indoors. What has been their experience and how they organise this; are they marking out the dancefloor and restricting the dances to ones that are essentially 'on the spot' (no weaves/ vines and only 180 degree turns, etc)?

Also, I wonder if any line dance teachers are giving thought to putting together a repertoire of 'on the spot' dances.

Thank you for everything you are doing to keep our CMC communities alive. It is all very challenging at present but, frankly, I cannot see much scope for a major restart until we have a vaccine in play. Kind regards, Nigel Karney, Woking, Surrey.

On Thursday August 13th in Fort Worth, Texas I was awarded Western Male Artist of the Year by the Academy of Western

Artists (AWA). Unfortunately, because of Covid-19 travel restrictions in the United States I was unable to attend the awards ceremony, however, I was able to watch the ceremony unfold over a live stream and was on the 'edge of my seat' as I waited to find out if I had won the best artist award which was the last category of the night. I'm extremely honoured to be the first British artist to win. I had also been due to perform at the ceremony and fully intended to be there, had it not been for the travel restriction to the USA. I now have an agent

on a tour which will hopefully happen after the current situation ends. Fortunately I hit the road early in January and February with my western band and was able to complete a very successful Scandinavian theatre tour before the travel bans and lockdowns started. We then played a series of shows in Germany and Holland, returning to England with only a day to spare before lockdown started, so we were very lucky. There's no denying that the virus has reaped havoc across the whole music scene, regardless of which genre you work within. I have lost 90 percent of all my live shows for 2020, which was shaping up to be an excellent year, gig wise. However I am now working on rescheduling

us are praying that the current situation will be behind us by 2021. I had begun to look at the possibility of preproduction on my next western album beginning in late 2021 but those plans will now be delayed until the future is a little clearer. Most independent labels,



Secret Sisters - Saturn Return



The Secret Sisters have released three full length albums since 2010 including their more recent, 2017's You Don't Own Me Anymore for which the twins received a nomination for Best Folk Album at the 60th annual Grammy awards. Saturn Return was recorded in Washington State and has 10 songs written by Laura and Lydia Rogers and features the sisters singing

individually for the first time, instead of relying solely on their trademark harmonies, which are impeccable. The album heralds the arrival of a new era for the ladies who have both undergone extreme change and transformation during the making of this album. Dottie West - The Cream Of The EMI Years



Dottie West enjoyed Country chart success from the early 1960s through to the mid 1980s. It has been said she was one of the finest and most influential female Country performers of her time. She possessed a distinctive and emotional singing voice and was one of the most popular and controversial performers to rise to popularity during the Nashville Sound era. As with her friends, Patsy Cline and Loretta Lynn, Dottie battled for identity and respect within what was a male dominated industry at that time.

Dottie's career started with her top 10 hit, Here Comes My Baby Back Again, which won her a Grammy award for Best Female Country Vocal Performance in 1965, the first female in Country music to receive a Grammy. This double cd compilation has 50 songs, which includes You And I, Hey, Mr Dream Maker, By Your Side, We've Got Tonite, Are You Happy Baby?, Right Or Wrong, Read My Lips, Overnight Sensation, If I Ever Cross Your Mind, The Night You Let Me Down, Hate The Lies - Love The Liar, Tulsa Ballroom and many more.

Album reviews

Larkin Poe - Self Made Man

Larkin Poe is an American roots rock duo originally from north Georgia currently living in Nashville, Fronted by sisters, Rebecca Lovell and Megan Lovell, their music features strong southern harmonies together with heavy electric guitar riffs and slide guitar. They performed at the 2014 and 2016 Glastonbury festivals and were voted Best Discovery of Glastonbury

2014.
Both sisters have also toured as backing musicians for a variety of other artists, most notably Elvis Costello, Conor Oberst of Bright Eyes, Kristian Bush of Sugarland and Keith Urban. Self Made Man follows their 2018 album, Venom & Faith, which was nominated for Best Contemporary Blues Album at this year's Grammy awards.

A lot is often bandied around regarding what is and what isn't Country music, which is a matter of taste. This album for me is a far cry from the Country music which I enjoy and would be better being promoted down the rock chic road, it was not for me I'm afraid.

There is no doubt the sisters harmonise well.

Martin Jaye - Troubadour

The song Troubadour is a ballad in which the narrator reflects on his life as a troubadour, feeling that he is content with what he has accomplished. I was a young troubadour when I rode in on a song / I'll be an old troubadour when I'm gone. One asks oneself could this be the thoughts of Martin Jaye who has now released his new album, Troubadour!

Included in this selection

are a variety of well known Country songs, both classic and modern, which compliment each other. We start our muiscal path with the excellent All My Ex's Live In Texas recorded in 1987 by my favourite artist George Strait. Cheap Cologne, Imagine That and Lost Highway come next with the tongue in cheek song, I'm Still Not Dead, sung originally by Willie Nelson.

The dance floor filler, Love Trip gets us on our feet next and carries us on to Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville. Guitar Town, Weymore Blues, Things I Carry Around, Frame Of Mind and the title track, of course, Troubadour. This Highway and Wasted Time which were both written by Martin brings this variety of tunes to a nice end.

Savannah - Still Holding Things Together

Seasoned entertainers, as solo performers, together as Savannah or as part of the band Louisiana, Chrissy Byrne and Mark Smith bring us their latest cd, Still Holding Things Together. They begin their ride through the Country music cycle mixing traditional with modern and what better way to start than with the dance floor filler, Love Her For A While, recorded by Sam Outlaw, which is a

good way to start this musical myriad of sounds with Mark taking the lead vocals. Chrissy keeps the up tempo mood going with the song Snowbird which was first recorded in 1969 by Gene MacLellan and she delivers this song beautifully. The dreamy ballad, If I Could Only Fly slows the tempo down before we are off again with Jolene and Evangelina, Sing Me Back Home and the

fabulous First Fool In Line which is always included in most UK acts repertoire. Holding Things Together, Texas Time, Things I Carry Around, Blame It On Your Heart, Footlights and Something Stupid end this excellent cd.

I cannot compliment Chrissy and Mark enough on their choice of songs, vocals and production, which are all first class. Brill!

Album reviews

Oh Susanna - Sleepy Little Sailor - Deluxe Edition

Born in Massachusetts and raised in Western Canada Suzie Ungerleider is singer/songwriter Oh Susanna, who is set to release her album, Sleepy Little Sailor in a deluxe edition which will be available on cd, digital and vinyl.

Featuring 11 songs, five of which are acoustic recordings, including the title track, Sleepy Little Sailor brought her a new found platform for her songs in 2000. They have now been beautifully reworked. Also included are six previously unreleased recordings alongside the original album. River Blue and Kings Road are newly recorded while Sleepy Little Sailor, Sacrifice and Beauty Boy are taken from the original demo sessions. These songs are as powerful

today as they were 20 years ago.

There is no doubt that her pared back acoustic versions highlight the effortless strength of her bewitching voice and her talent for songwriting. With her emotive crystalline voice and folky sound she has been compared to a number of Americana artists, with Gillian Welch being one of them.

Frank Renfordt - The Cumberland River Project

The Cumberland River Project is the self-titled album from German songwriter, Frank Renfordt. He crosses a vast musical soundscape of Country music with occasional influences from pop to blues to rock.

Despite this diversity his own songwriting is unmistakeable in all of the 13 songs included which were inspired by Jon Pardi, Alan Jackson and Jason Aldean.

The opener, Back On The Road sets the tone of the songs which are intermingled with some punchy, drum and guitar driven sounds mixed with the traditional elements attributed to Country music.

Summer's Gone, Hometown and what we are seeking at the moment -Craving For The Beach are standout tracks for me. After saying that I enjoyed listening to every one of the 13 songs on here which are well worth a listen over and over again. There were one or two tracks which I found very danceable and would be a must for any choreographers out there. This is a must have album for fans of solid Country music with a penchant for Brothers Osborne, Josh Turner or Justin Moore. I loved it!

Patsy Thompson - Fabulous

It has taken Patsy
Thompson 12 years to
record this new album. Due
to family obligations she has
had to put her career on the
back burner but now things
are looking much rosier. It's
a new beginning and a time
to move on for her.
What matters is that the
Canadian born singer/
songwriter made her way to
Texas and back and now
West Coast audiences will
only be better for it.

Fabulous Day is her 6th cd produced by Chris Rolin who also lent his extraordinary guitar talents throughout the album. Patsy has a rich tone one minute, moving onto a raw edge the next and then smooth and tender with a hint of soul. The title track, Fabulous

The title track, Fabulous Day begins the first of 10 tracks on the album, it is a roaring number which takes you on a ride full of passion before we move on to Neon Lights and Picking You Up, a foot stomping song. Dreamin' slows the mood down to a musical interlude of wonder and is for me the best song on the album. Other tracks worth a mention are Passion and I Think About You. This album is aptly named because I thought it was just fabulous and well worth the wait.




